Their commissions are all in excess of one million dollars per year. The firm even hired Bill Malcolm and Shawn Blakeslee's brothers. The antics in the office continue against anyone who is not white, straight, male and a friend of Bill Rice. They have had several complaints/ lawsuits filed over the past few years, but settled all of them before they got to court.

The only consolation is that your documentary cost them a lot of money in lost commissions by clients who saw it and were horrified by their behavior.

As I work on Wall Street, I must remain anonymous. However, the information I've provided you with is easily verified.
